## Marriage, God's Plan Says:

**One man & one woman**-Matthew 19:4-6 says *And He answered and said to them, Have you not read that He who made them at the beginning made them male and female, and said, for this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh? So then, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let not man separate.* Marriage was created to relieve loneliness, provide companionship, bear & nurture children and provide proper leadership for creation (Genesis 1 & 2).

**Bound until death**-Romans 7:2 says *For the woman who has a husband is bound by the law to her husband as long as he lives. But if the husband dies, she is released from the law of her husband.* Agreeing to spend your life with your spouse means until the end, for better or for worse, in sickness & health, for richer or poorer. And I say to you, whoever divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another, commits adultery; and whoever marries her who is divorced commits adultery.* Two circumstances are given for the right to marry a second time: death of the first spouse & sin of fornication by the spouse.

**Marriage** continues to be a polarizing topic socially & culturally. Society is embracing the world's plan for **marriage** instead of God's plan! Will you follow God's plan for **marriage**?

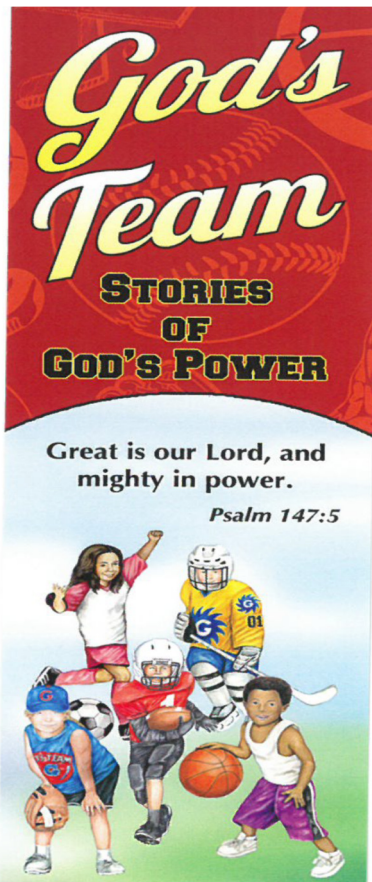
