-Not to be consumed with this world: Colossians 3:1-2 says *If then you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.* Let's not be preoccupied with the mundane, earthly comforts that may motivate us. Jesus is the source of our spiritual lives & our reason for living. Jobs, vacations, events, and possessions are fine to have. But, do you live for the things in the world or for Christ Who is sitting at the right hand of God?

-The church should be mission minded: II Peter 1:8 says For if these things are yours and abound, you will be neither be barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. 
God's desire for us is that we rise up above the fear and dread that cripples so many (cf. 2 Tim. 1:7).
