## Prayer Breakfast

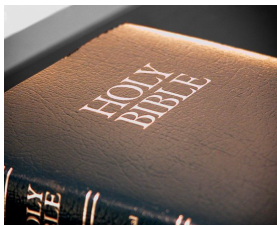

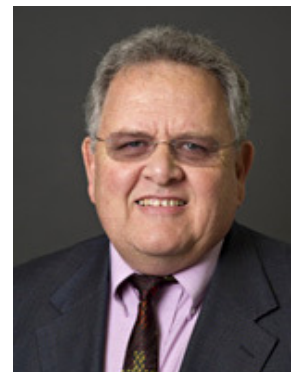
