We are free to choose our career path, to choose where we live, & to choose who we vote for during elections. When it comes to worship, our commitment to spiritual matters, & the religion we practice, Scripture is the guide, not our choices! Society tends to say, "one group is as good as another." The word *denomination* is used to compartmentalize religious bodies. Webster's Dictionary defines the word *denomination* as "a religious organization whose congregations are united..."This false thinking implies truth doesn't matter and the Lord's church is not unique or separate from the world.
