#### MISSION STATEMENT

We are missionaries and evangelists who are in charge of two churches in Honduras. I, along with my oldest brother, Carlos Jr., and my wife, have been working with these churches for three years. Our priority is to help them grow spiritually and in number. We go door knocking every week to reach potential new members, and we also have Bible studies with the families of the brethren. Our goal is for each church to be self-supporting. We have worked hard to prepare our men for leadership and our women for all the services that they can do. We also work with our youth because we know that they are the future of the Church, and that includes the younger children as well.

#### MISSION BACKGROUND

I had the privilege of growing up in a Christian home. My father, Carlos Hernandez Sr., has been a preacher for 30 years. When I was a teenager in the early 2000s, I started to learn about evangelism. Soon after, I joined the ministry with my father. My wife and I had the opportunity to study at The Bible School of the Americas in Panama. We spent two years studying the Bible full time.

When we returned to our country, we started the ministry of preaching and evangelism in our home church. Just a few months later, we had the opportunity to work as a team with my brother, Carlos Jr., in two churches. Since then, we have been working full time in these two churches. We also work on missions in other areas of Honduras as well as other countries in Central and South America.



My wife and I have been married for seven years. We have a four-month-old daughter named Hadassah.







## PREPARING FUTURE EVANGELISTS

Every Sunday, we have a 45 minutes ladies' class and men's class before worship. Our leadership is very strong, and our ladies work very hard as well. Each week when we go out to knock doors, they are always ready to go with us. They prepare meals for their children and husbands very early so that they can be ready for the evangelism work. We are very proud of the progress we are making in Honduras, and we thank you for supporting us as we work in these two churches.

#### JUDITH'S WORK: SUPPORTING THE CHILDREN

Unfortunately, these are very poor towns, and 80% of women with children are single mothers. For that reason, my wife, Judith, has been working to help gain support for the children in our churches. She has been assisting six families by helping them with supplies for their children each month. In addition to this we have more families with the same needs, and we are working on helping them as well.
