The Everlasting Arms

"There is no one like the God of Jeshurun, Who rides the heavens to help you, And in His excellency on the clouds. The eternal God is your refuge, And underneath are the everlasting arms; He will thrust out the enemy from before you, And will say, 'Destroy! Then Israel shall dwell in safety, The fountain of Jacob alone, In a land of grain and new wine; His heavens shall also drop dew. Happy are you, O Israel! Who is like you, a people saved by the Lord, The shield of your help And the sword of your majesty! Your enemies shall submit to you, And you shall tread down their high places."

Deuteronomy 33:26-29

Moses was ordered by God to go up to Mount Nebo where he would be allowed to view the land of promise. He, however, would die on the mountain and was not allowed to enter the land because of his transgression at the waters of Meribah Kadesh. Before he ascends the mountain, Moses blesses the tribes of Israel who will eventually enter the land of promise and possess it. He reminds Israel that God is their true refuge and underneath are the everlasting arms. This is a great statement of confidence and comfort.

Anthony Showalter was principal of the Southern Normal Music Institute in Dalton, Georgia. In his life he published over 130 music books, and he held singing schools in many local churches. He always took a special interest in his students and kept up with them through the years. One evening in 1887, he was leading a singing school in Hartselle, Alabama. When he returned to his boarding house two letters had arrived from former pupils. Each of the young men were heartbroken because their wives had died.

Showalter began to search the Bible looking for a passage to comfort these young men. He settled on Deuteronomy 33:27, "...underneath are the everlasting arms...." As he meditated on the verse, he came up with the words for a chorus: "Leaning, leaning, safe and secure from all alarms; Leaning, leaning on the everlasting arms." He wrote replies to his bereaved friends, and then he wrote to his friend and hymnist Elisha Hoffman. He said that he had written a chorus for Deuteronomy 33:27, but he could not come up with the verses. Hoffman wrote three verses and sent them back to Showalter. This song "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms" has cheered and comforted many who find themselves in adversity. (*Then Sings My Soul*, Robert J. Morgan)

"What a fellowship, what a joy divine, Leaning on the everlasting arms! / What a blessedness, what a peace is mine, Leaning on the everlasting arms!

"Oh, how sweet to walk in this pilgrim way, Leaning on the everlasting arms! / Oh how bright the path Grows from day to day, Leaning on the everlasting arms.

"What have I to dread, what have I to fear, Leaning on the everlasting arms? / I have blessed peace with my Lord so near, Leaning on the everlasting arms.

"Leaning, leaning, Safe and secure from all alarms; / Leaning, leaning, Leaning on the everlasting arms."

Charles Spurgeon wrote: "God, the eternal God, is our support at all times, especially when we are sinking into deep trouble. There are seasons when we sink quite low.... Dear child of God, even when you are at you lowest, underneath are the everlasting arms." The psalmist affirms, "The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear?" (Psa. 27) My friend, may you rest secure leaning on the everlasting arms!
