Looking Like Someone Else

While it is fun to think of or meet someone who we may resemble or vice versa in relation to appearance or mannerisms, let us remember when it comes to our spiritual walk, we are to be distinct in our pattern of living and the way we worship and live out our faith. **Romans 12:2 says:** *And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*

- We are called to live differently than the world.
- We are challenged to behave differently than the world.
- We are encouraged to have different priorities than the world.
- Conforming to Christ sharpens our view of eternity.

When we live differently, we aren’t living with our head in the sand, but living with our eyes on Heaven! The sacrifice of Christ allows us to be compassionate, not calloused to the cause of Christ.
